**NOTING** the powers of a Pre-Trial Judge as set out in Rule 65 *ter* of the Rules;

**PURSUANT TO** Article 13 *quater* of the Statute and Rules 54 and 65 *ter* of the Rules;

**DESIGNATE:**

Judge Ole Bjørn Støle as Pre-Trial Judge for this case.
