#### **DECISION ON ACCUSED’S MOTION TO SUBPOENA MILENKO ŽIVANOVIĆ**

On 23 April 2013, the Chamber granted the accused’s motion and issued a subpoena against Milenko Živanovic, former Commander of the Drina Corps of the Republika Srpska Army, in order to testify for the Defence in this case on 8 May 2013.

### **HADŽIĆ case**

*Trial Chamber II – Judges Delvoie (Presiding), Hall and Mindua*

#### **DECISION ON PROSECUTION MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME FOR COMPLETION OF ITS CASE-IN-CHIEF**

On 24 April 2013, the Chamber granted the Prosecution an additional ten hours in which to lead its evidence against Hadžić. Therefore, the Prosecution will now have a total of 185 hours to present its case.
