#### **ORDER FOR SAFE CONDUCT**

On 10 July 2013, the Chamber granted safe conduct for witness Svetozar Andrić, former Chief of Staff of Drina Corps of the Republika Srpska Army, in order to give testimony as a Defence witness in this case. The safe conduct means that “*while in or travelling to The Netherlands for the sole purpose of his testimony in the present case, and while returning to Serbia thereafter, he shall not be arrested, detained, prosecuted, or subjected to any other restriction, whether physical or legal, of his personal liberty, in respect of alleged acts or convictions prior to his departure from Serbia.*” He was subpoenaed on 29 May and his testimony is scheduled for 19 July this year.

#### **CORRIGENDUM PUBLIC AND REDACTED VERSION OF THE 27 MARCH 2013 DECISION OF PRESIDENT ON EARLY RELEASE OF RADOMIR KOVAČ**

On 11 July 2013, Judge Meron issued a corrigendum to public redacted version of his decision from 27 March this year granting the early release motion of Radomir Kovač. The corrigendum clarified that Kovač’s early release was effective on 30 June 2013 and not on 31 May 2013, as previously written.
