### **JUDGEMENT (PRESUDA)**

On 24 July 2013, the Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian translation of the appeals judgement against Gotovina and Markač was filed. The judgement was pronounced on 16 November 2012 resulting in the acquittal of both accused.
