### LATEST NEWS:

#### **BABIĆ Case**

*Trial Chamber I, Section B - Judges Orić (Presiding), El Mahdi and Martín Canivell*

On 2 June 2004, the Trial Chamber deferred the delivery of the Babić Sentencing Judgement until further order (see *Press Advisory* No. 178).

### PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

#### I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

#### **BLAGOJEVIĆ and JOKIĆ Case (“Srebrenica”)**

*Trial Chamber I, Section A – Judges Liu (Presiding), Vassilenko and Argibay*

Eighth week of the Defence case.

From 1 to 4 June 2004, the following witnesses were examined by the Defence and subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution:

- Protected Witness DP 105
- Witness Desimir Bučalina

#### **KRAJIŠNIK Case (“Bosnia and Herzegovina”)**

*Trial Chamber I - Judges Orić (Presiding), El Mahdi and Martín Canivell*

Eighth week of the Prosecution case.

On 1 and 2 June 2004, witness Charles Kirudja was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence. On 3 and 4 June 2004, the hearing took place in closed session.

#### **HADŽIHASANOVIĆ and KUBURA Case (“Central Bosnia”)**

*Trial Chamber II - Judges Antonetti (Presiding), Rasoazanany and Swart*

23<sup>rd</sup> week of the Prosecution case.

On 1 June 2004, Witness Torbjorn Junhov was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence. From 2 to 4 June 2004, the Prosecution presented video evidence.

#### **DECISION ON PROVISIONAL RELEASE**

On 2 June 2004, the Trial Chamber ordered the provisional release of the Accused, on medical grounds, to the republic of Serbia and Montenegro for an initial period of six months, subject to the terms and conditions set out in the Decision (see *Press Release* No. 854).

**REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER**

On 1 June 2004, the Trial Chamber rescheduled the Status Conference for 14 June 2004 at 10 a.m.

**DECISION ON MOTION BY VOJISLAV ŠEŠELJ CHALLENGING JURISDICTION AND FORM OF INDICTMENT**

On 26 May 2004, the Trial Chamber ordered the Prosecution to clarify the ambiguities in paragraphs 11 and 12 of the Indictment. Otherwise, it dismissed the complaints made in Vojislav Šešelj’s Motion of 24 December 2003. The Decision was filed on 3 June 2004.

**DECISION ON REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FILED BY THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS**

On 3 June 2004, the Trial Chamber granted the Kingdom of the Netherlands’ 2 June 2004 Request for an extension of seven days for its response to the Decision of 27 May 2004 (see *Weekly Update* No. 315). It further requested that Mr. Karremans appear as a witness at the earliest on 16 June or at the latest on 22 June 2004.
