JUDGEMENT

On 31 January 2005, the Trial Chamber delivered its Judgement in the Strugar case. Pavle Strugar was found guilty pursuant to Article 7(3) of the Statute of one count of attacks on civilians, and one count of destruction or wilful damage done to institutions dedicated to religion, charity and education, the arts and sciences, historic monuments and works of art and science (both counts are violations of the laws or customs of war under Article 3 of the Statute). He was sentenced to eight years' imprisonment (see *Press Release* No. 932).
